PYKKA is one of them. Despite all these successes, it is pertinent to mention that the sports infrastructure in India is still not at the desired level, and this creates an obstacle in developing sports in the country.

The twenty four government and thirty two private colleges of the Hyderabad Karnataka region those colleges were represented inter university wrestling competitions.


#### **Research Tool**
