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# A SURVEY ON SPORTS FACILITIES AND SPORTS PARTICIPATION IN THE GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE DEGREE COLLEGES OF HYDERABAD KARNATAKA REGION

The sports facilities having the vary importance matter for the development of the sports performance in the degree colleges, without the sports facilities we cannot imagine the sports development in the colleges of Hyderabad Karnataka region. The present study based on the survey method to analysis the sports facilities and sports performance in the government and private colleges of Hyderabad Karnataka region. The main objectives of the study to know the sports facilities in the government and private degree colleges and also compare the sports facilities of athletic events in the government and private colleges. To know the influence of sports facilities on the sports participation and performance. The hypothesis stated that there would be difference in sports facilities of athletic events among government and private colleges of Hyderabad Karnataka region. There would be influence of sports facilities on the sports participation and performance of the players belonging to the colleges. The sample of the study – 24 government and 32 private colleges those who have actively participated at inter university level sports competitions. The percentage method used in the study to analysis the status of sports facilities in the colleges and also the sports performance at inter university athletic competitions.

# **INTRODUCTION**

# **Development of Sports in India**

**Abas** (1982) conducted study on the facilities and equipment of sports in engineering colleges in West Bengal and found that the student teacher ratio was satisfactory and only one college provided special coaches different games and sports. Only three engineering colleges out of five had sufficient playground facilities. Sufficient equipment and playgrounds were not found in all the selected engineering colleges as per their student's strength.

This study will be evaluated the sports facilities provided to the college students who have been representing and participating in inter university level Athletic competitions. (2012-17) This study also highlighting the lacunas in the sports facilities in the colleges both government and private.

# Objectives of the study

- ➤ To know the sports facilities in the government and private degree colleges of the Hyderabad Karnataka region.
- > To compare the sports facilities of athletic events in the government and private colleges.
- To compare the sports participation and performance in athletic events

# **Hypothesis**

- > The hypothesis stated that there would be difference in sports facilities of athletic events among government and private colleges of Hyderabad Karnataka region.
- ➤ There would be influence of sports facilities on the sports participation and performance of the players belonging to the colleges.

The sample of the study -24 government and 32 private colleges those who have actively participated at inter university level sports competitions. The percentage method used in the study to analysis the status of sports facilities in the colleges and also collected the five years sports participation in inter university athletic events.

#### **Tool**

The self structured questionnaire prepared by the research investigator was used as a tool in the present study, the questionnaire given to the physical education directors / principals of the selected colleges and asked them to fill the related information about the sports facilities available in the college arena. And also collected sports participation at inter university athletic competitions from 2012-2017.
