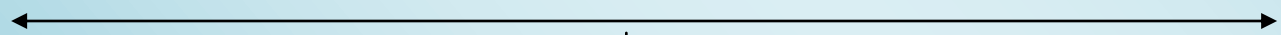

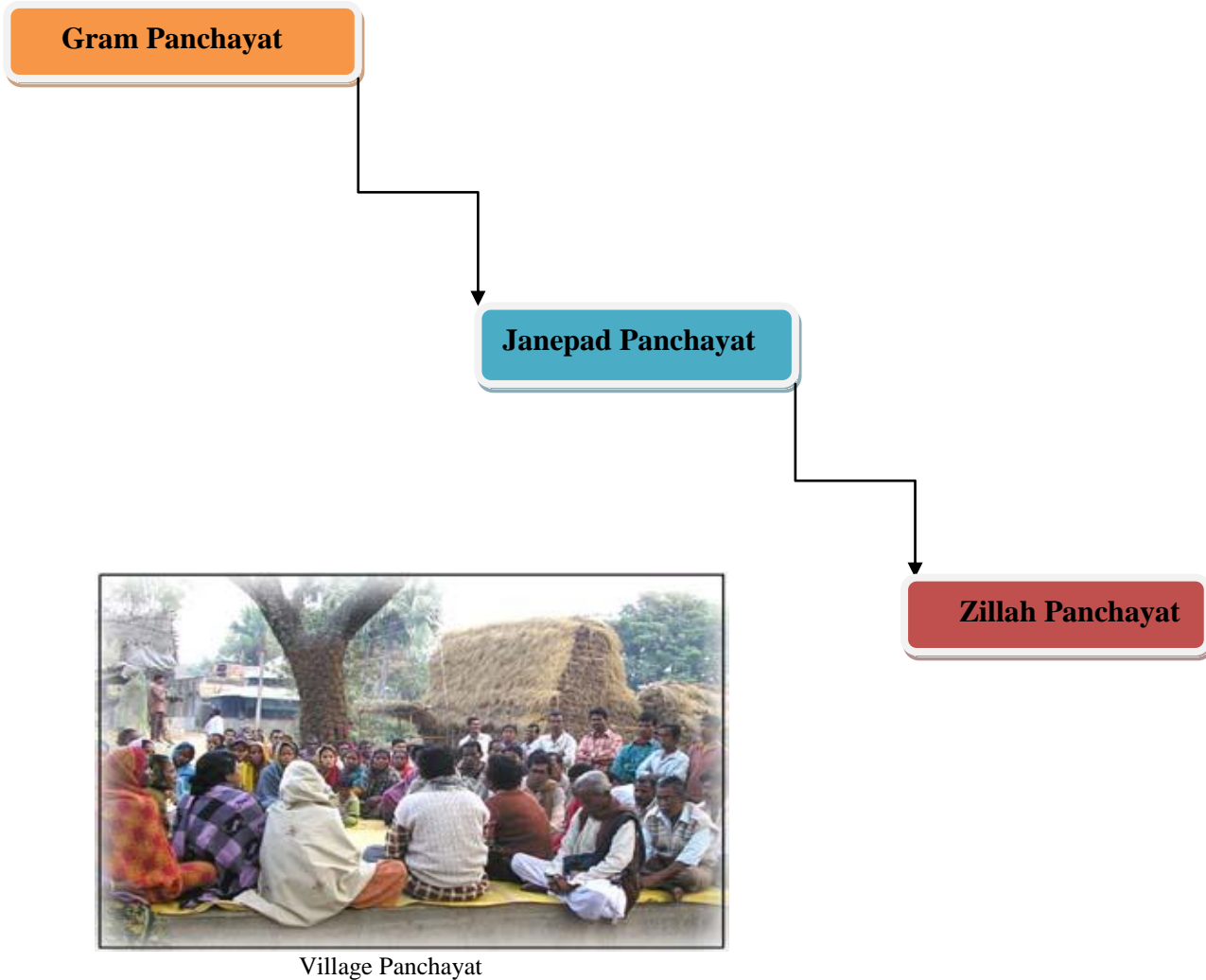
INTRODUCTION

Those who are specially elected or nominated to that entity. Persons who get to participate in local bodies should not have any decisive, but only advisory role. During British rule Panchayat system was in worse condition. After independence it was introduced in country on the base of three tire system. Various committees were formed for the development of panchayati raj. At present India has 250001 panchayats.

METHODOLOGY

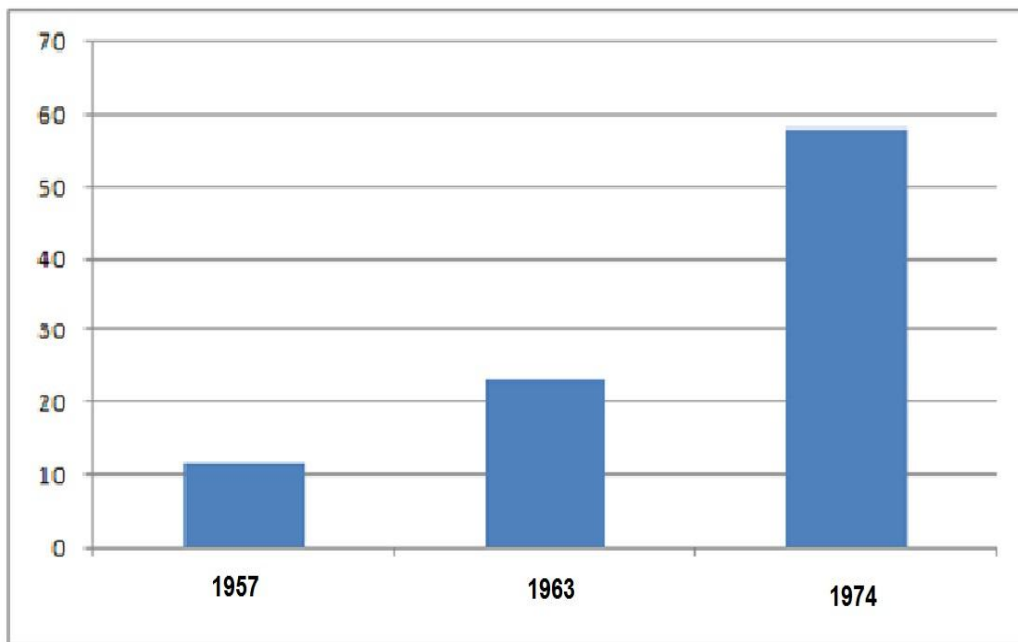
The present study was carried out in the state of Madhya Pradesh. The survey of the area was conducted during January to June 2012. The study was carried out in following three phases:

3. Verification of data

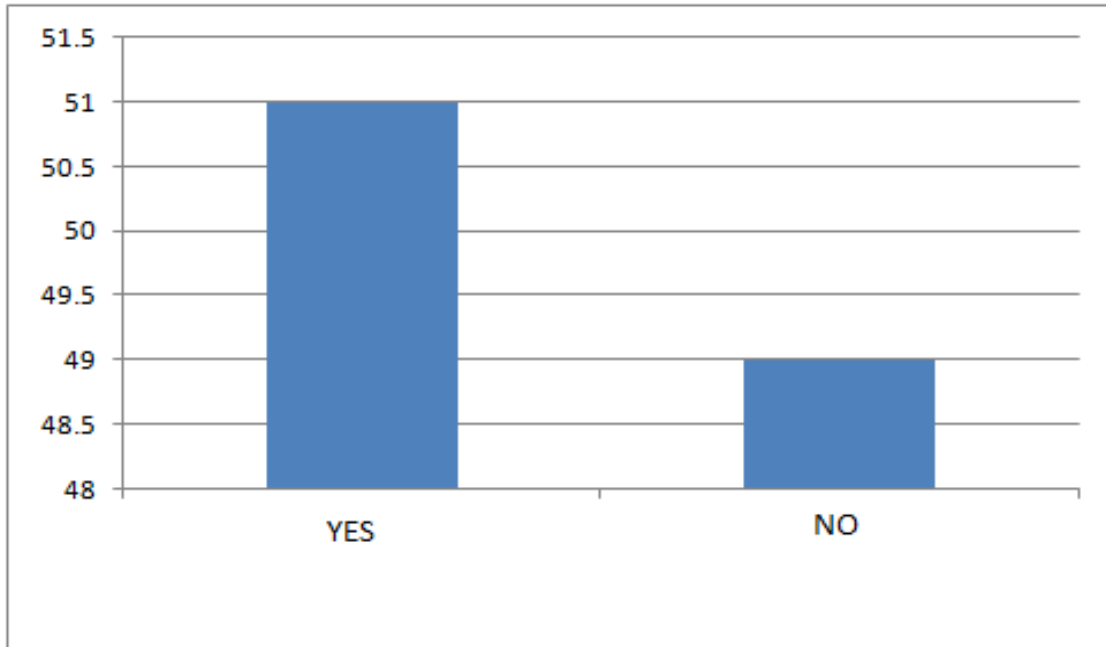

Results obtained from questionnaires are as under:

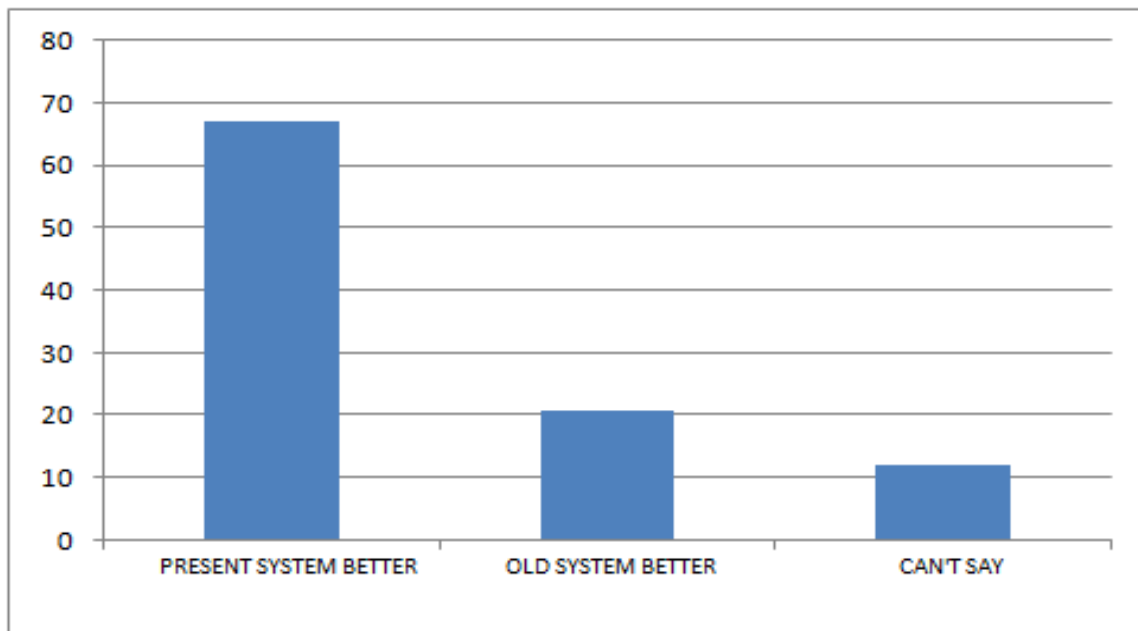
Q. No. 1. When the Panchayat system was established in Madhya Pradesh?



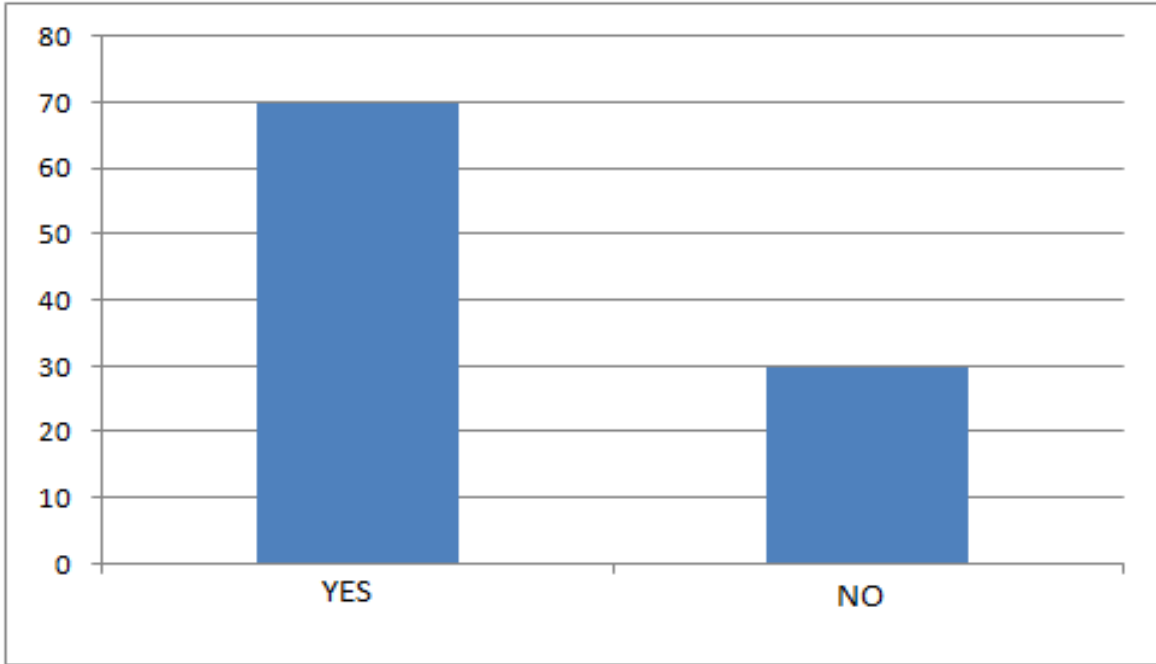
Q. No.2. Do you know the role of panchayats?



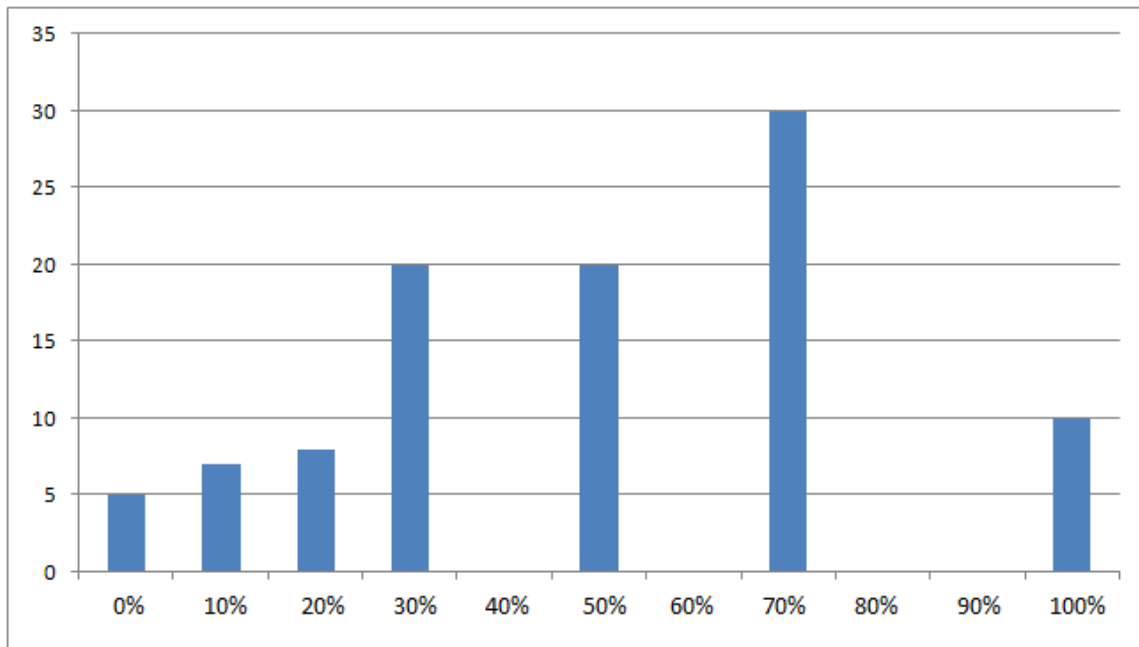
Q. No. 3. Which Panchayat system is good old or new?



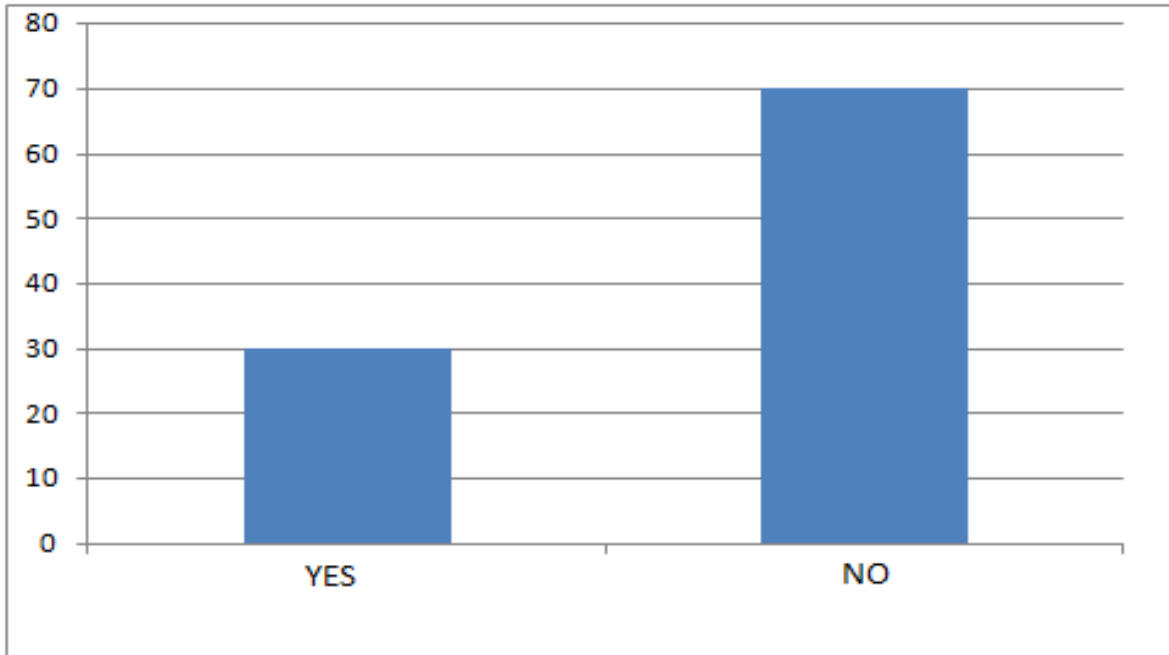
Q. No.4. Are you aware about the schemes of panchayati raj implemented in your state?



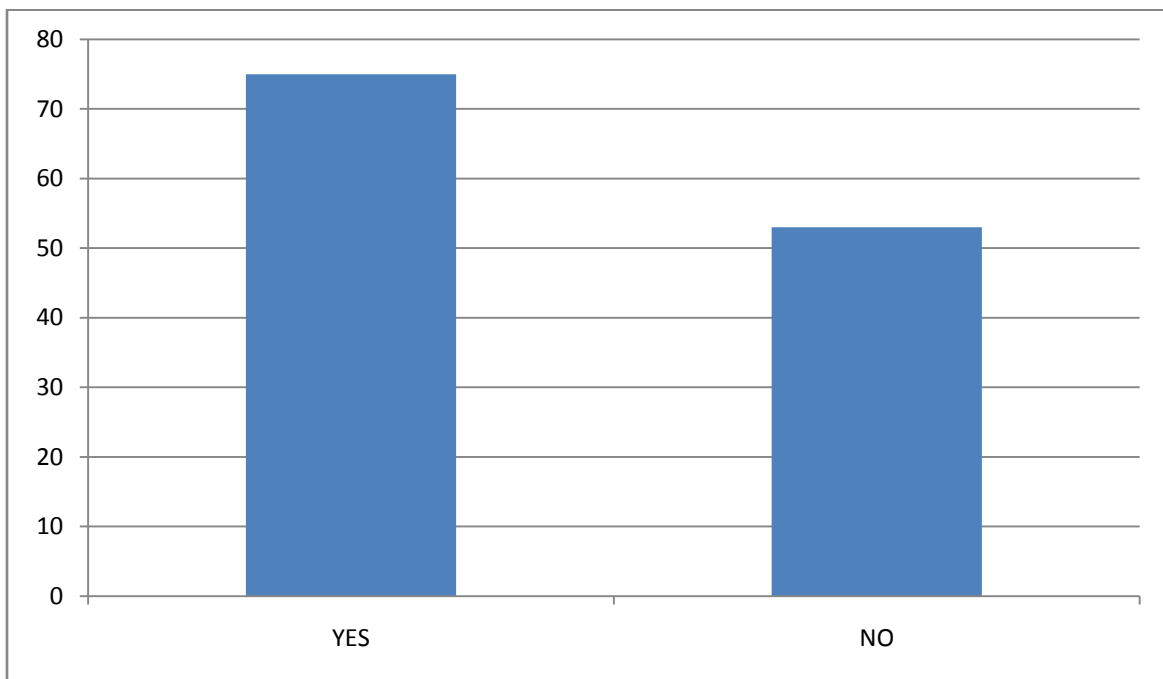
Q.No.5. How much panchayati system is effective for the development of villages?



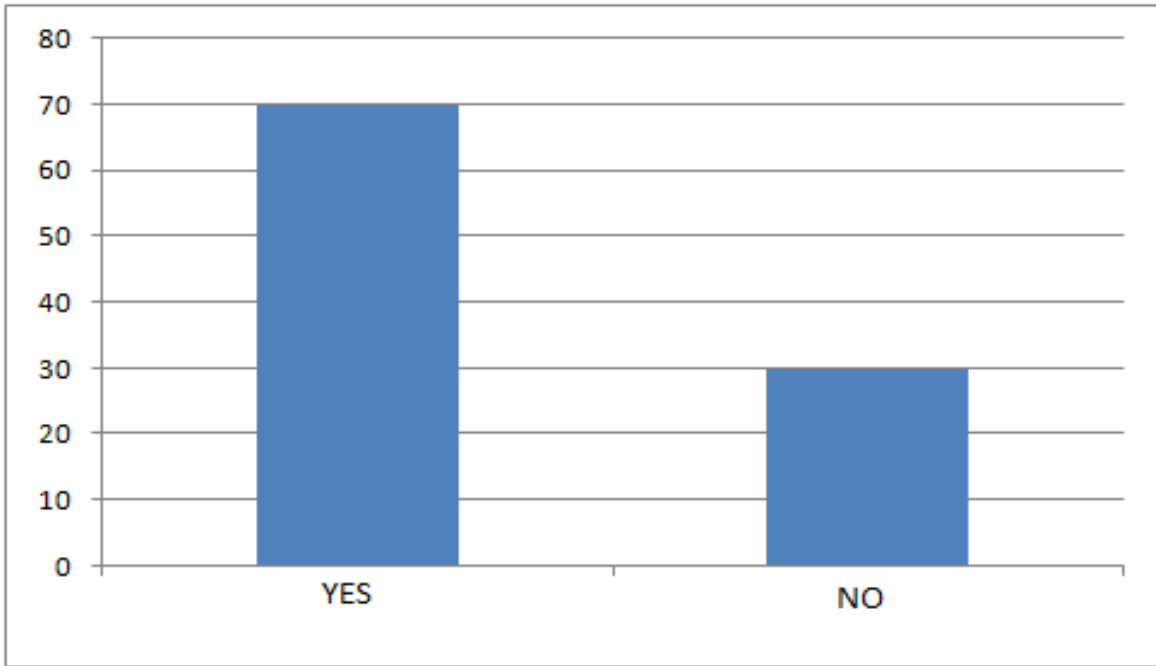
Q.No.6. Has panchayati raj reduced the untouchability by giving equal opportunity to all sections?



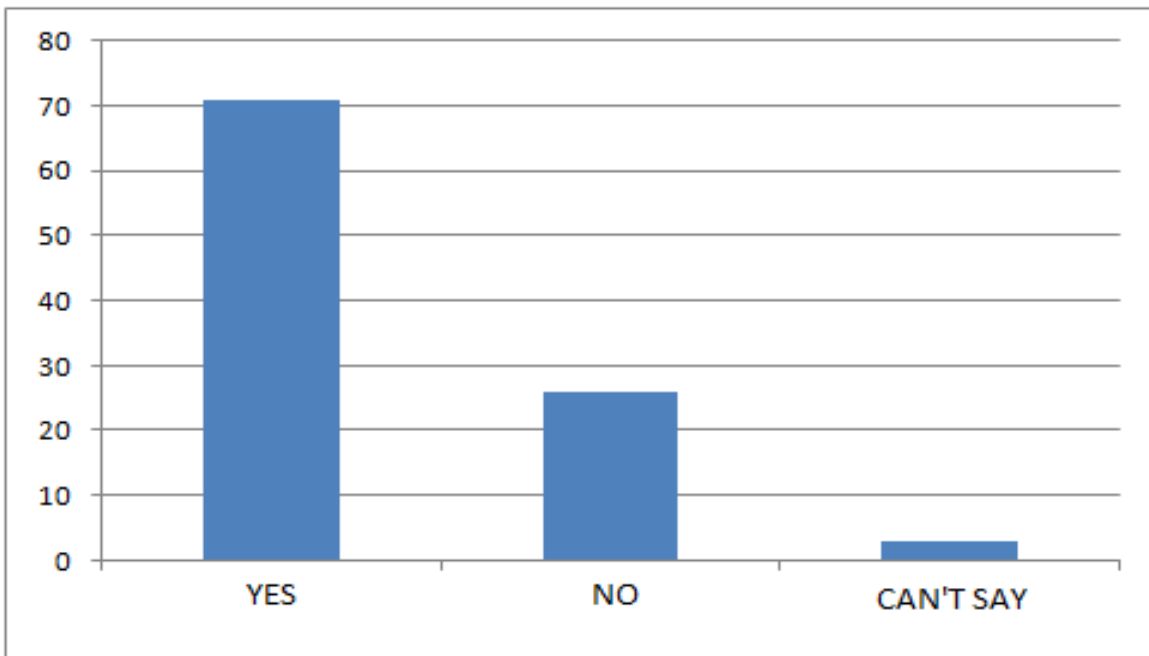
Q.No.7. Do you think that panchs & Sarpanchs should be at least intermediate passed?
